Advances in Orthopaedic Therapies

Fri 3 - Sat 4 November

Rainbow Equine Hospital, York, UK

The following orthopaedic therapies will be interactively discussed via an evidence-based approach and the speakers will also explain how they personally use these modalities: Autologous conditioned serum & protein solutions, alcohol-facilitated ankylosis, PrP, acellular amnion, autologous vs. allogeneic stem cell therapy, new OA therapeutics (i.e. polyacrylamide hydrogel), bisphosphonates, Adequan/Cartrophen, nutraceuticals, intra-/extra-articular corticosteroid & hyaluronan, sports horse surgeries etc. Alcohol-facilitated ankylosis of the distal tarsal joints and ultrasound-guided injections will be trained on equine specimens and simulators as part of the wetlabs.

Advances in Foot Lameness & Farriery

Fri 17 - Sat 18 November Mälaren Hästklinik AB, Stockholm, Sweden

This course approaches the subject of farriery and therapeutic shoeing in a scientific and as objective way as possible by reporting established facts and recent, cutting-edge findings from scientifically sound clinical studies. The anatomy, physiology and biomechanics of the foot will be covered, followed by lectures on trimming, shoeing, different shoe types, what effect they have on the foot, how to examine the foot and how to deal with specific foot problems. The 7 hours of practical sessions will give attendees plenty of opportunity to put theory into practice on live horses and limb specimens in small groups (2 vets per specimen) and to discuss all aspects of foot trimming, shoeing, foot radiography and general farriery with the specialists.


Advanced Cardiology (max. 24 vets)


Ultrasonography has become a crucially important diagnostic imaging modality and a growing number of equine orthopaedic specialists have extended its use creatively to assist with injection techniques and to facilitate minimally invasive surgery. This course was developed for equine practitioners to enhance their knowledge and practical skills of performing ultrasound-guided orthopaedic injections and ultrasound-assisted surgical techniques. Between both afternoons, 7 hours of practical sessions will provide the opportunity to train many different injection techniques on horses, equine specimens and anatomic replica simulators in true small-groups (2-4 vets per ultrasound machine).

Rehabilitation for Lower Limb Tendon & Ligament Conditions


Developed for equine practitioners & physiotherapists with a good working knowledge of distal limb tendonitis and desmitis, this course covers how to devise rehab protocols consisting of a combination of therapeutic exercise, use of different rehabilitation modalities and therapeutic shoeing to maximize horses' chances of returning to previous levels of exercise. The 7 hours of practical small-groups sessions on live horses and case-discussions will allow attendees to become familiar with therapeutic modalities and physical therapy exercises that can be passed on to horse owners.

Musculoskeletal Ultrasound

This course provides equine practitioners with the knowledge and especially the practical skills to competently and confidently identify frequently encountered equine musculoskeletal conditions affecting the frontlimb, hindlimb and neck of the horse. The 7 hours of practical sessions in true small groups (2 - 4 vets per ultrasound machine) will provide attendees with extensive opportunity to hone their scanning skills at the following stations on live horses: Machine set-up, heel & pastern, digital flexor tendon sheath & annular ligament, fetlock region, flexor tendons & check ligaments, suspensory ligament (FL vs. HL), tarsus & tarsal sheath and the stifle joint region.

Musculoskeletal imaging is discussed by comparing radiography with other complementary imaging modalities accessible to equine practitioners (especially ultrasound, but also MRI, CT and PET) through which additional information can be gained. The 9 hours of wetlabs (x-ray and ultrasound) on live horses and multi-modality case discussions provide plenty of opportunity for attendees to further develop their radiography, ultrasound and image interpretation skills under the supervision of equine diagnostic imaging clinicians.
